



BLAST 2019

We are glad that you are interested in Blast Camp at Quest Church. Enclosed is information regarding camp that should answer most of your questions.

Blast is for 4 year olds through 8th grade. All campers are required to have a 2019 registration form on file. This form is good for an entire year and can be updated as needed. There is a one time 2019 registration fee of \$20 per child.

Included in this packet is a scheduling calendar for Spring Blast and Summer Blast. Please give us your best estimate as to what days your child will be attending (I know plans may change or aren't set yet). You are not committing to anything; we use it for staffing purposes. You only pay for the days your child attends. We offer short days, 9am-3pm and long days, 8am -6pm. Short day fees are \$17 per child per day and long days are \$22 per day per child. If your child is here for a long day we provide a morning and afternoon snack. You may submit your registration form, scheduling calendar, and registration fee to the church office M-F 8am-4pm or email Allison at AWengert@questpc.org or fax (407-299-2124). If the forms are emailed or faxed we will collect the registration fee on your child's first day of camp.

Lunch may be purchased for \$5 per day (see included menu). Lunch orders must be in by 9:30am. If you will be late dropping off your child you must call in their lunch order to 407-293-3696. If your child is packing their lunch, we do not have access to keep it cold or heat up items.

Payment is required at drop off for either the day or week, including lunches. We accept cash, check (payable to Quest Church) or credit card. If you are later than 6pm picking up your child, there is a \$1 per child per minute late fee.

Children need to be signed in & out. If they are old enough and you have paid in advance, you do not need to come in to sign them in. Only the people listed on the authorized pick up list will be able to pick up your child. If you will be having someone who is not on the list pick up your child, you must inform the staff upon check in. You must add their name to the pick up list on the registration form.

Children should wear comfortable clothing and shoes appropriate for running & outdoor play. Please no flip-flops, sandals or heelys. During the summer, Wednesdays are our water day. Please have your child come in their bathing suit (no revealing suits) with suntan lotion already applied. Cover-ups and shirts over top of their bathing suit is fine. We encourage water shoes to avoid injuries. Pack a towel and a set of clothes including a pair of shoes for them to change into.

BLAST is a privilege to attend and we will not tolerate any destructive or abusive behavior. We reserve the right to withdraw any child for repeat offenses.

The following items are not permitted at Blast Camp.

Candy, including gum

Fidget Spinners

Toys that mimic weapons

Cell phones (for students in 5th grade and under)

If you feel the need for your child in 5th grade and under to have their phone, it will be kept at the check-in table. However, we prefer that you contact the camp directly at 407-293-3696 for any necessary communication.

If your student is entering 6th grade or above, there are times where they are allowed to use their cell phones and electronics. The campers will be told that the expectation is that all music, games, and apps that they use must be appropriate for this church campus. They will also be monitored as best as possible by our Blast counselors during this time. Your child will be responsible for their cell phone and electronics that they bring to camp.

Should you need to reach the camp during the day you can call the church office at 407-293-3696. If we are unavailable, please leave us a voicemail and your call will be returned.

WHAT HAPPENS EACH DAY AT BLAST, YOU ASK!

8:00-9:45 - Students enjoy freeplay upstairs. There is a variety of activities including video games, arts and crafts, and board games. All grades are mixed at this time while counselors are supervising and interacting in different areas. Students who are part of our long day option will be offered a snack at 8:30.

9:45-11:30 - Students will split into their teams and rotate to different areas of the campus for games and activities. Teams are separated by grade level and are accompanied by two or more counselors. Some of the areas are: outside, FLC (our big indoor space), game room, and specials area. Each rotation last approximately 30 minutes.

While students are rotating, we also have engaging tasks they complete in the specials area. See below to see the daily themes.

Math Mondays: Students will interact with math facts using games, puzzles, and friendly competition.

Text Tuesdays: Students will connect with text by reading, completing crosswords and word searches, and creating writing pieces.

Water Wednesdays: No rotations, just fun in the sun! Students will be outdoors between 9:45 and 11:45 to enjoy water slides, basketball, and the occasional balloon/shaving cream fight.

Theme Thursdays: Students will participate in worship and a brief message led by one of the Journey Youth directors, Johnny. Every Thursday, students can also participate in our weekly dress up days.

Fun Fridays: Students and counselors will complete team bonding exercises, community building projects, and lively team challenges. Students are encouraged to wear their team color on Fridays to show their team spirit. This day is always a blast!

11:30-1:45 - Students will continue in their teams for lunch, outdoor recess (playground), and large group games in the FLC.

11:30 - Youngers Lunch (Pre-K to 1st grade)

12:15 - Middles Lunch (2nd to 4th grade)

1:00 - Olders Lunch (5th grade and up)

1:45-3:30 - Students in Pre-K to 5th grade will watch a movie (rated PG or under). Students in 6th grade and up will have an opportunity to use their electronics and play games with supervision from counselors.

3:30-5:00 - Students will break into two large groups for upstairs and downstairs freeplay. Students who are part of our long day option will be offered a snack after the movie.

5:00-6:00 - Students will finish up with outdoor recess on the playground (weather permitting) or inside play.
